
#### Learner Information

## **Erasing Images**

You can select and erase images one at a time. Please note that erased images cannot be recovered. Exercise adequate caution before erasing an image.





- Press the **D** button.
- The last image you took will appear.



### Select an image to erase.

Press the buttons to select an image.





Press the ◀▶ buttons to select [Erase], then press the ∰ button.

- The displayed image will be erased.
