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Learner Information and Tasks:


Images can be erased from a digital camera to get rid of pictures you don't want or to clear memory space. Look at the instructions on page 20 from the Canon Camera user's manual.

- **Task 1:** How many images can you erase at one time?
- **Task 2:** What will appear when you select the playback mode?
- **Task 3:** Circle or highlight the button you press to erase an image.
- **Task 4**: What cannot be recovered?



Erasing Images

You can select and erase images one at a time. Please note that erased images cannot be recovered. Exercise adequate caution before erasing an image.



Select the playback mode.

- Press the button.
- The last image you took will appear.



Select an image to erase.

Press the buttons to select an image.



Erase the image.

- Press the ▼ button.
- Erase?] appears.
- Press the ◀▶ buttons to select [Erase], then press the ∰ button.
- The displayed image will be erased.
- To exit instead of erasing, press the buttons to select [Cancel], then press the button.







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Answer Key

Task 1: You can only erase ONE image at a time.

Task 2: When you select the playback mode the last image you took will appear.

Task 3: The button marked "FUNC SET" should be circled (there are two places they could do this).

Task 4: Erased images.
