Task 2: List an activity that transport truck drivers perform.

Answer: Transport truck drivers drive straight trucks or tractor-trailers to transport freight. Long-haul truck drivers operate heavy trucks over urban, interurban, provincial and international routes, while short-haul and local transport truck drivers operate over urban and short interurban routes.

Task 3: What is the educational requirement for this job?

Answer: Completion of secondary school is usually required. Completion of an accredited driver training course may be required. Specific class licenses may be required for driving specific vehicles.

Task 4: List three specialized skills that may be required for this job.

Answer: Post Trip Inspections, Pre Trip Inspections, Repair, Global Positioning System (GPS), Bill of Lading, Navigation Equipment, Truck Driving, Forklift Operation, Lifting Ability, Commercial Driving.
