Activity	Amount of Time Required
Assisting with bathing	1.5 hours
Assisting with other personal care and grooming (e.g. brushing teeth, brushing hair, toileting needs)	30 minutes
Light housekeeping (e.g. washing dishes, cleaning floors, etc.)	1 hour
Meal preparation	1 hour
Assisting with eating	1 hour
Daily client documentation	30 minutes

Task 1: Complete Emily's weekly schedule using the information provided. Include 30 minutes of travel time to each client's home before beginning homecare tasks. Include a 30 minute lunch break anytime between 11am and 2pm.

- Mr. Adams requires assistance with bathing, other personal care, meal preparation, and eating assistance on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Mrs. Shah and Mrs. Chen each require light housekeeping and meal preparation. Mrs. Shah is scheduled for assistance every day. Mrs. Chen is only scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Mr. Joshi requires assistance with meal preparation on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Answer:

The learner should have scheduled the following into Emily's schedule:

Mr. Adams' home: 1.5 + 0.5 + 1 + 1 = 4 hours Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Mrs. Shah's home: 2 hours every day.

Mrs. Chen's home: 2 hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Mr. Joshi's home: 1 hour on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

A sample answer is shown here but scheduling could be done differently. Morning and afternoon appointments could be switched, for example. As long as the learner has allocated enough time for each task, travel, and lunch, then their schedule is correct.

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# Task 2: How much time does Emily spend travelling to clients' homes on Tuesdays?

Answer: 1.5 hours. 30 minutes each spent travelling to Mrs. Chen, Mr. Joshi and Mrs. Shah.

#### Task 3: How much total time, including documentation time, does Emily spend in Mr. Adams' home each week?
