Answer: \$1 per container

Task 3: What happens if someone does not return a ReuserID container within five (5) days of borrowing it?

Answer: A refundable deposit of \$7 is applied (to your account) after 5 days, but this will be automatically removed if the container is returned within 30 days.

Task 4: How does someone return a ReuserID container?

Answer: There are two ways to return a container:

- Smart Bin: Scan the container QR code, the door will open then place your container inside the bin.
- Return Station: Scan the kiosk QR code and place it on the dish belt or in the bin.
