- Task 8:** What are two examples of the various other credits found in the T1 Return? **Any two of the following:**
- **Tax deducted at source**
 - **CPP and/or EI overpayments (if they separate these out they will count as two)**
 - **Provincial or territorial tax credits**
 - **Installment payments**
- Task 9:** When is the deadline to file an income tax return?
- Deadline to file is April 30th of the following year (they may also add June 15th for self-employed individuals and their spouses or common-law partners)**
