- Helps you identify sources of income
- Reminds you of expenses you can deduct and tax credits you can claim
- Helps you determine taxes owing
- Helps prevent problems if the CRA reviews your return
- Task 2:What are the two potential consequences for not keeping complete records or any other
proof?
 - 1. The CRA may have to determine your income using other methods
 - 2. The CRA may also disallow expenses you deducted and the credits you claim
